WICHITA EAST, FREDONIA, LEON WIN STATE TRACI CHAMPIONSHIPS

Leon Only 1948 Champion To Repeat; Mayo Sets New High Hurdle Record; Dal Ties Class B High Hurdle Record; New L ow Hurdle Marks Established.

Wichita East's Blue Aces won back the Class AA Track Championship they lost to Topeka in 1948, by outdistancing the field with a total of 49 points. Their closest rival was Shawnee Mission with $37\frac{1}{2}$ points, followed by Wyandotte with 23 and Independence with 20. Topeka, the 1948 AA champion, scored 6 points.

1949 TFF

Fredonia won its first title by making a total of $20\frac{1}{2}$ points for the Class A championship. Kingman was second with $15\frac{3}{4}$ points, followed by Lyons with 14 and Holton with 12. Ottawa, defending champion for Class A, scored $1\frac{1}{2}$ points.

Leon scored a total of 21 points in Class B and was the only 1948 title holder to repeat this year. The nearest competitors were Pretty Prairie and Immaculata (Leavenworth) with 15 points each and Coldwater with 14.

The meet was held May 20 and 21 at the University of Wichita before one of the largest crowds ever to witness a State Track Meet. The track was in fine shape despite heavy rains the night before the finals.

Wally Beck, Shawnee Mission's star sprinter, pulled a muscle in the 100 Yard Dash and his performance the remainder of the meet was not up to par. The Mile Relay team which he anchored withdrew from this event entirely.

Ronnie Mayo of Wichita East, defeated his teammate Byron Renner in the 120 Yard High Hurdles to establish a new state record of 14.6 in this event. The old record was 14.9 set by Porter of Winfield in 1937. Ray Dahl, Leon's star hurdler, tied the Class B High Hurdle record of 15.1 set by Dean of Glen Elder in 1946.

All marks in the 180 Yard Low Hurdles established a record for this event since this is the first year the race has been run. Previously the distance had been 200 yards.
